<u>CHANGES</u>: Welcome to the first DS of GA newsletter for 2019, a year of changes for our Society. Many may ask why have we made changes in our meeting schedule, tuber sales and the show schedule.

Most of our meetings are geared to our newest members and other less experienced members to provide growing information in order to help them to be successful in all aspects of bringing their dahlias to bloom. While we have had a number of new members join our Society over the past few years, most do not attend our monthly meetings. As a result, in most cases, our programs were being presented to experienced growers with a depth of knowledge beyond what was being presented.

We have reduced our Spring tuber sales from two to one which will be held in early May this year and in future years. The reason for this change is the lack of tubers available from our members in order to hold two sales. The past two years we have had to rely on purchased tubers bought from commercial growers in order to have sufficient tubers to choose from during our April sale.

We will not have a show in September, 2019. The number of growers willing to show their dahlias has been reduced due to various reasons throughout the four dahlia clubs that make up the Southern States. In past years we have had a show in Asheville, Chattanooga, Atlanta, Birmingham and the National Fair in Perry. It has become very difficult to support all of these shows each year so the Southern States Dahlia Societies have agreed not to support the show in Perry any longer and starting in 2019, a rotating schedule of shows where one show will not be scheduled each year except for the Carolinas which will have a show each year. The show in Atlanta will be dropped for 2019 but will return in 2020.

MARCH MEETING The March meeting will be held on Saturday, March 16th, at 11:00 AM, in the Turner Theater located in the entrance building of the Atlanta Botanical Garden.

The program will include a DVD presentation of the American Dahlia Society New Introductions for 2019 and getting your garden ready for planting your dahlias.
